



### TRIPLE J GUAM HOSTS GUAM'S FIRST DRIVE-UP MOVIE FUNDRAISER









On Saturday, January 9th, Triple J held Guam's first Drive-Up movie event – Reels and Wheels – a way for the company to stay connected as a community during COVID-19 and to raise funds for the Guam Memorial Hospital Volunteers Association.

Only a limited number of tickets were sold for the event and was sold out back in November, but due to the rise in COVID cases at the time, the event was postponed until after the holiday season.

AMC is working closely with each village Mayor on scheduling of outreach efforts to prioritize patients most in need.


