




Smokin Wheels

MISS MARIANAS

Newly-crowned Ms. Marianas, Jian Joyner drove off in a brand-new, 2015 Hyundai Elantra GLS coupe. The bigger, Elantra 4-door sedan was named the North American Car of the Year at the 2012 North American Auto Show and has been one of Saipan's best-selling sedans since 2012. The 2-door coupe that Ms. Joyner is driving is a unique, sporty offering perfect for a sophisticated-yet-hip, younger generation and comfortably seats five passengers.

Equipped with a fuel-efficient, yet powerful 2.0 liter, 173-horsepower, 4-cylinder engine, Ms. Joyner will enjoy the fuel-economy of approximately 30 milesper-gallon on Saipan's island roads. The Elantra GLS coupe holds an EPA highway fuel-rating of up to 34 mpg and has a 6-speed, electronically-controlled automatic transmission. She will also enjoy the convenience of remote, keyless entry with power windows and locks.

For safety, Ms. Marianas can drive secure knowing that her Elantra is equipped with six airbags; two on the dash, one on the side of each front seat and side air curtains offering head protection to occupants of both rows of seats. The Elantra GLS coupe also has front-and-rear anti-lock disc brakes and a factory-equipped back-up camera and monitor for safe backing out of driveways and parking spots.

For entertainment, the Elantra GLS coupe is equipped with an AM/FM/CD/MP3 stereo with six speakers. Ms. Marianas' car is also equipped with USB and auxillary ports as well as Bluetooth so she can plug in a flash drive or connect her phone to play her favorite music.
